URC 2018 Student Participant Survey – Highlights

A total of 508 students responded to the URC 2018 Participant Survey.

- Of the 500 students who answered the question regarding how they had heard about the URC, **91% reported that they had heard about it from a faculty mentor/adviser**, underscoring the great influence that faculty mentors have in encouraging students to pursue this high-impact experience.
- Of the 483 students who answered the question regarding how the URC compared with other academic experiences at UNH, 34% of respondents reported that their URC experience was <u>one of the top three</u> most rewarding aspects of their UNH education, while 93% reported that the URC was <u>in their top</u> <u>ten</u>.
- Of the 486 students who answered the question regarding the degree to which their participation in the URC improved certain skills, at least 80% of respondents indicated that the URC allowed them to improve or very much improve in the following areas: 1) creating a clear, organized presentation; 2) communicating complex ideas to a general audience; 3) sharing ideas with colleagues in their field; and 4) developing a deeper understanding of their subject discipline.
